A programme of activities (PoA)

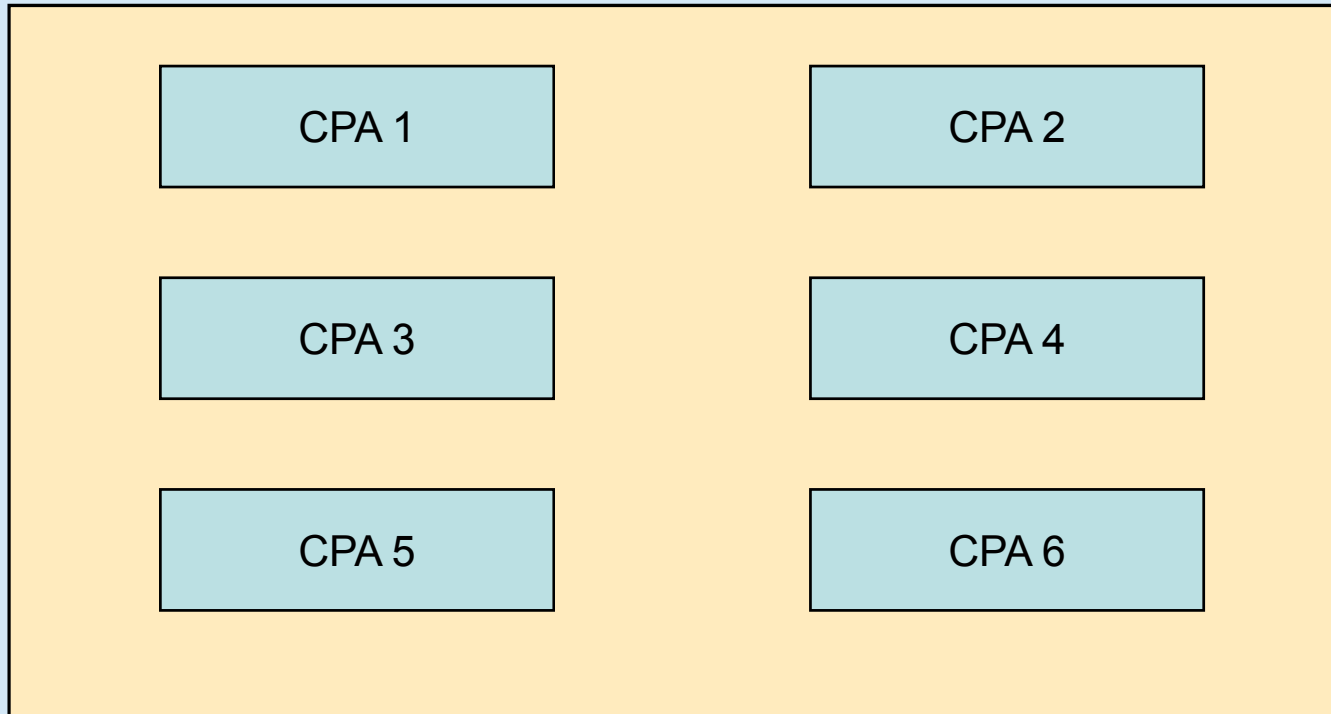
- voluntary coordinated action by a private or public entity
- for coordination and implementation of any policy/measure/goal
- leading to GHG emission reductions or increase removals by sinks additionally, via an unlimited number of CDM program activities.

CDM programme activity (CPA)

- project activity under a programme of activities.

not registered, but submitted for registration within 4 weeks after “on hold” of the methodology	applicable
not registered and not submitted for registration within 4 weeks after “on hold” of the methodology	not applicable

- Affect of withdrawal of AM CPA projects

CPA projects	Approved Methodology (“withdrawn”)
registered	applicable
Not registered, but: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. published for public stakeholder comments for validation 2. submission for registration within 8 months of the date of effective of revision 	applicable
Other not registered CPA projects	not applicable

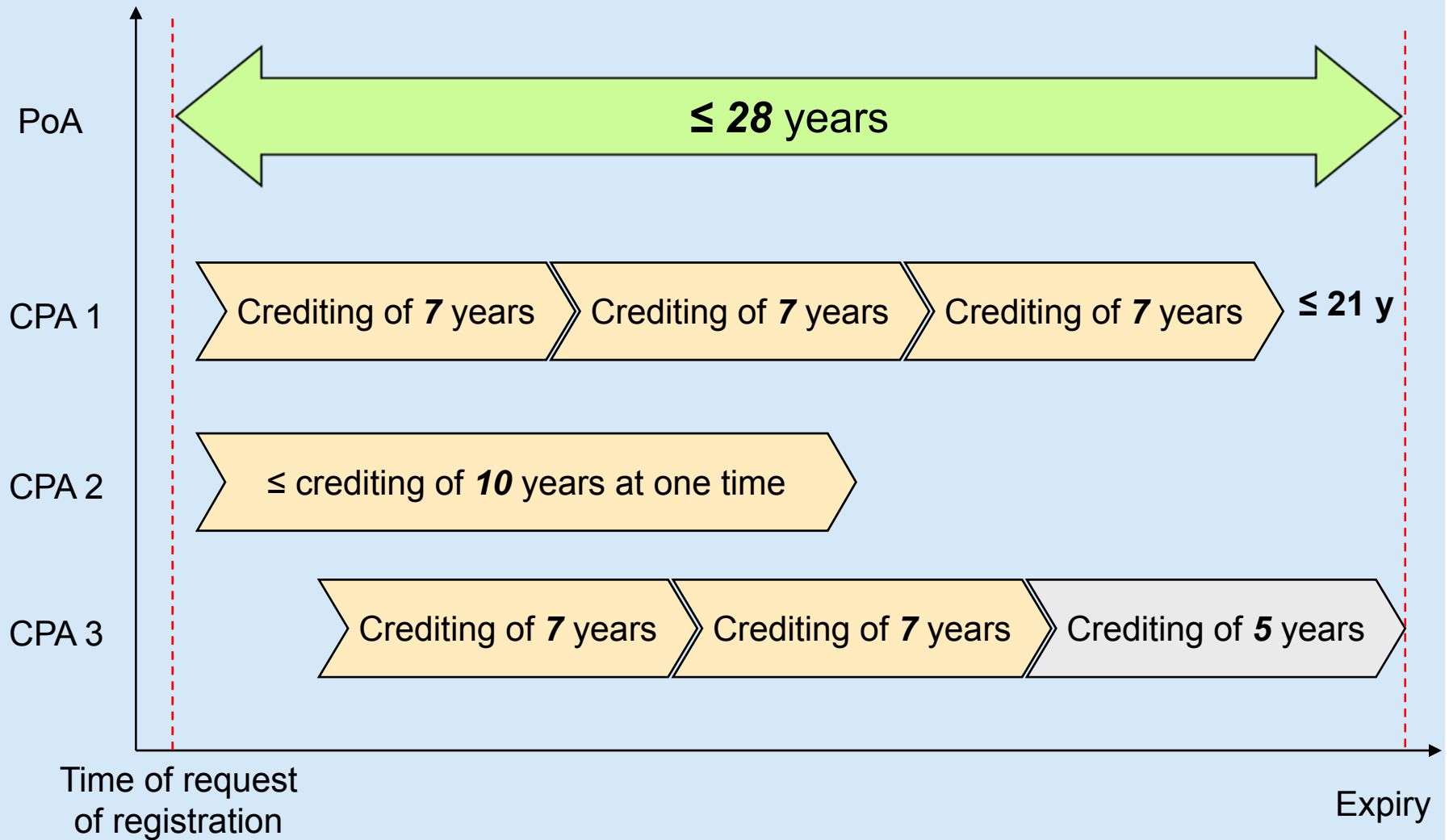
■ Methodology of a PoA

- All CPAs of a PoA shall apply the same AM, involving one type of technology or set of interrelated measures in the same type of facility/installation/land.

■ Registration fee

CER (t CO ₂ e / year)	Registration fee (USD)
< 15,000	0
1,757,500 ≥ CER ≥ 15,000	$[(15000 \times 0,1) + (CER - 15000) \times 0,2]$
> 1,757,500	350,000
